Lake Burrendong State Park offers year-round attractions for fishing enthusiasts, nature lovers, bushwalkers, campers and picnickers. With an arboretum with native plants and animals, and a mass of subtropical vegetation and local bird life, Lake Burrendong has something for everyone.

Location

Lake Burrendong State Park is only one hour's drive from either Dubbo or Orange and five hours from Sydney. If you are coming from the north of the state, the park is 27kms south-east of Wellington.

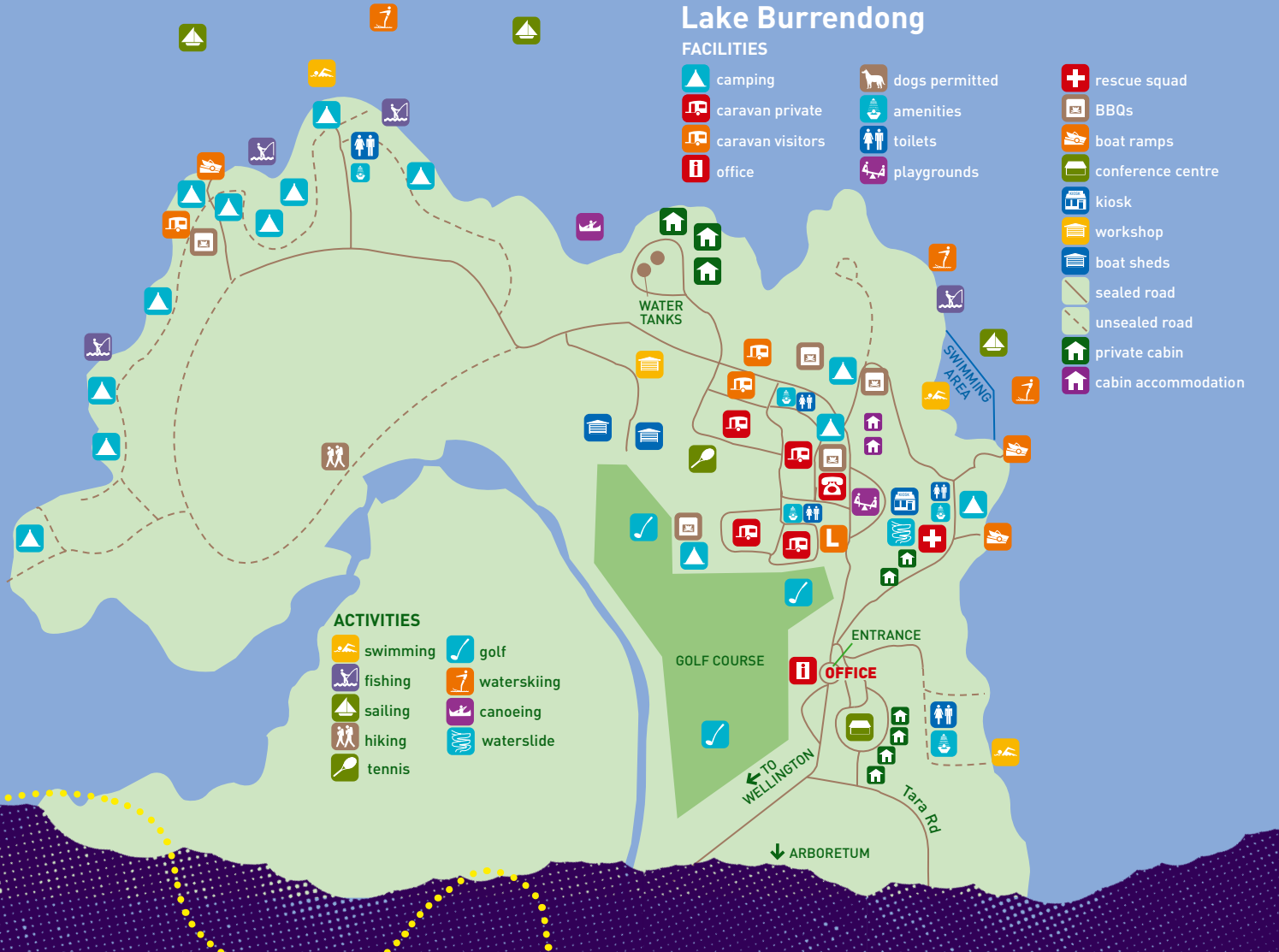

- Fish for redfin, golden perch, catfish and cod or even freshwater crayfish

- Half an hour away, the historic town of Wellington offers many sites, including limestone caves
